## **SESSION 7 SUMMARY:**

In session 7, we began to bring everything together from our last couple of sessions in order to begin drafting our strategy map. The strategy is a picture of the process that shows how the church will accomplish the mission on the broadest level. It provides a map rather than a menu. It integrates a "training center", normalizing the development of learning leaders. Your strategy becomes your This is your disciple-making pathway. It lets "Joe" and "Johanna" know where to go next.

SESSION 7 ACTION TIMES:	
	<b>Draft your Strategy Map</b> Spend time as a team working to draft your strategy map in a simple napkin drawing that includes both a picture/diagram and a high-level language of the components of your strategy.

Of course, any vehicle you choose multiplies through relationships because all disciple-making is relationships.
