SESSION 6 FOLLOW-UP & ACTION ITEMS

SESSION 6 SUMMARY:

In session 6, we celebrated the progress you've made thus far as you presented your **all-play, everyday mission statement** as well as a shared picture of your **Dream Disciple**. We then conducted a live modeling exercise to demonstrate how your Dream Disciple can be used in a leader/emerging leader huddle experience.

Each team drew a picture of their current strategy, naming its strengths and weaknesses in helping them to develop their Dream Disciples. We then introduced the next master tool called the **Kingdom Platform.** Our disciple-making pathways must empower disciples to become leaders in their relational spheres of influence. We used the **Leadership Star** to identify five skills needed to be a person who is easy to follow.

Finally, we introduced the **DISC game (<u>watch instructions</u>)** to re-imagine a disciple-making pathway in our contact that moves from merely an "attend-connect-serve" paradigm to one that forges a multiplication paradigm where disciples are identified with their special calling, trained to reproduce in all of life.

SESSION 6 ACTION TIMES:

Dream Disciple Refinement & Test Drive

Continue to refine your Dream Disciple based on the coaching we gave in session 6. Each of you should start personally using the Dream Disciple questions in your own walk with the Lord and test drive them with those you are investing into. Let's see what personal stories begin to surface from your life and those you're leading/discipling.

Strategy Prototyping

Continue to explore the Strategy Prototype exercise to get to a design that could help shift the paradigm in your context. The goal is to get to move from ABC disciples to A to Z disciples. Feel free to engage some other staff/leaders in the exercise. This will help to create some scaffolding as we move to refine or reimagine your disciple-making pathway (strategy map).
